The Department of Educational Foundations and Leadership is pleased to offer an 18-credit-hour Technology Facilitation Endorsement online beginning fall 2011. This endorsement will prepare teachers to serve as a technology integration mentor and/or facilitator for colleagues in their schools and districts. The endorsement is obtained through an application process to the Ohio Department of Education and upon approval will be added to your teaching license.

The endorsement can be used to complete a Master's Degree in Instructional Technology. Individual school districts, not the state of Ohio or The University of Akron, determine the extent to which the endorsement is applicable to their needs and requirements. This endorsement is designed to prepare teachers to be effective users of technology in teaching practice of their colleagues at building and district levels. It is not intended to develop skills in computer repair, network maintenance or computer programming languages.
